The Championship Golf Course (two complimentary rounds per guest)

A round on the majestic Dave Thomas designed championship course is an unforgettable experience. Two years after it opened in 1992, Bowood was voted one of the Top Ten New courses in Britain by Golf World magazine, and a year later the same publication placed it in the Top 50 Destinations in Europe. Today Bowood is widely recognised as one of the finest courses in the south of England. The course weaves effortlessly through 200 acres of 'Capability' Brown's mature parkland, with cavernous moulded bunkers, skillfully planned hillocks defining the fairways, and vast rolling greens, every aspect in perfect harmony with the park.

Bowood House & Gardens (complimentary entry during the season April-October)

Purchased by the 1st Earl of Shelburne (1705 - 1761) in the mid 18th century, Bowood House and Gardens have been improved by successive generations up to the present day. Many famous architects and garden designers have been employed, including Henry Keene, Robert and James Adam, 'Capability' Brown, C.R. Cockerell and Sir Charles Barry.

A visitor to Bowood today will see fine 18th century architecture and splendid interiors: the Adam Orangery, the Chapel and Library by C.R. Cockerell, the New Hall, the Sculpture Gallery and the Laboratory where Dr Joseph Priestley discovered oxygen in 1774. There is also a series of exhibition rooms with a wealth of fine furniture, costumes, porcelain, jewellery and paintings on display. Outside, the house is surrounded by 'Capability' Brown's stunning park; there are magnificent formal gardens, a 'Picturesque' rockwork garden; and the renowned pinetum and arboretum.

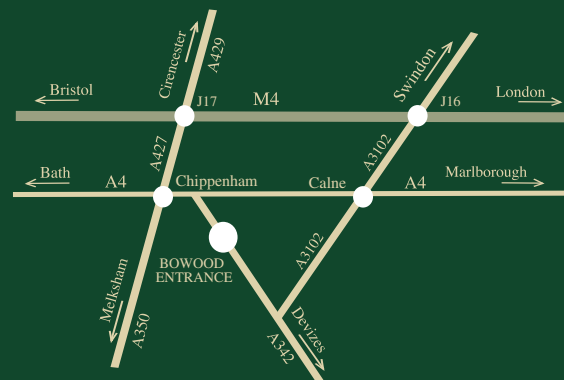
Bowood Rhododendron Walks (complimentary entry during the flowering season)

For six weeks during May and June, Bowood's rhododendrons are in flower, the walks are situated in a spectacular 60 acre garden on a separate part of the estate. This woodland garden of azaleas and rhododendrons is considered to be one of the most exciting gardens of its type in the country.

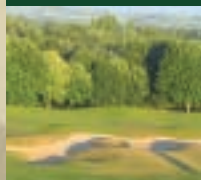
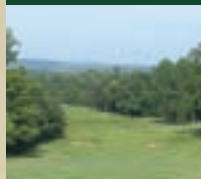
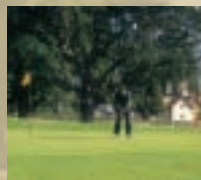


The Exclusive Retreat...
